

PRINCE GEORGE MONUMENTAL 100 MILER

Spectator information, route and water point access.

Prince Albert to Water Point 1 (Kobus se Gat) - 32KM

This section of the route, where spectators are allowed to share the same route as the riders, are from Prince Albert to Water Point 1 at Kobus se Gat. All spectators will however have to depart from Prince Albert well before the race start. Spectator vehicles will be allowed access to the Swartberg Pass before the race start until 06:45 and after 07:30. No exceptions in this regard.

These measures are put in place to ensure a premium rider experience and to ensure that riders are kept safe. Vehicles that depart prior to the race start are not allowed to stop on-route and must please proceed directly to the water point.

Water Point 1(Kobus se Gat) to Water Point 2 (Highgate Ostrich Farm) - 51KM

All spectators have to take the R328 via Oudtshoorn from water point 1 to water point 2. This is the fastest and most accessible route. No vehicles will be allowed to share the route with the riders and most of it is anyway inaccessible for a vehicle.

Water Point 2 (Highgate Ostrich Farm) to Water Point 3 (Herold) - 54KM

All spectators have to take the N12 towards George and then the N9 to Herold. This is the fastest and most accessible route. No vehicles will be allowed to share the route with the riders and most of it is anyway inaccessible for a vehicle.

Water Point 3 (Herold) to Blanco Primary School (Blanco, George) - 32KM

All spectators have to take the N12 towards George via the Outeniqua Pass and no access to Montagu Pass will be allowed. The finish is at Blanco Primary School.

Riders are allowed to receive outside assistance only at the water points. No outside assistance on-route is allowed and any person/vehicle transgressing in this regard that can be linked to a rider will result in the immediate disqualification of the respective rider/s.

Rider safety is our highest priority and of paramount importance hence these measures – the race organisers' decision in this regard is final.
